
<u>Instrumental</u>

"The instrumental view holds that, in one way or another, childhood is valuable for the sake of what it will later become. In other words, the child has value because he or she has the potential to become an adult."

Intrinsic

"The intrinsic valuation, on the contrary, holds that childhood has its own value, irrespective of later developments. In this view, the child has an intrinsic worth, and has both rights and responsibilities that correspond to her worth."



1.D. CHILDREN ARE MOSTLY IN THE CARE OF THEIR MOTHERS

- 32 YEARS AS A LCMS PASTOR
- MOST THE TIME MOM IS THE ONE DRIVING THE CHILD TO CHURCH ACTIVITIES
- MOST THE TIME MOM IS THE ONE TOURING OUR PRESCHOOL AND REGISTERING THE CHILD
- MOST THE TIME MOM IS THE ONE ACCOMPANYING THE CHILD IN THE WORSHIP SERVICE

- DIVORCE COURTS GIVE
 CUSTODY TO THE MOTHER
 (80%) MORE THAN THEY DO
 TO THE FATHER
- WHEN A MOTHER IS NOT MARRIED TO THE FATHER, AND THE DOMESTIC ARRANGEMENT COMES TO AN END, MOTHER KEEPS THE CHILDREN IN HER CARE






- ALL MALE SALESPERSON






WHAT IS MODERN MOM?

- A SOCIAL LANGUAGE
- How to communicate to Mom
- HOW TO UNDERSTAND MOM'S CURRENT WORK ENVIRONMENT
- HOW TO SPEAK INTO THE PRESSURES MOM'S WORK ENVIRONMENT PLACES ON HER

- RECOGNIZE THAT MOM IS POLITICALLY POWERFUL
- RECOGNIZE MOM IS SEEKING
 TO HUDDLE WITH OTHER
 WOMEN TO FIND SUPPORT FOR
 HERSELF AND HER CHILDREN
- RECOGNIZE THAT THE CHURCH APPEARS DISTANT TO MOM IN PART BECAUSE OF ITS PATRIARCHAL STRUCTURE



The Ministry with the Most Contact Hours Has the Least LCMS Training

- Rev. Dr. John W. Oberdeck reported in the Lutheran Education Journal that only 8.2% of the LCMS clergy have experience teaching preschool students.
- "9% of early childhood educators are certified by the denomination as 'ministers of religion, commissioned," according to Judith Christian.

The Relational Demography of Pastor and ECEC Director


LCMS Ordained Pastor

- A Member of a LCMS congregation
- ► A member of the synod
- Attended a LCMS seminary for 4 years
- Made a "quia" subscription to the Book of Concord
- ▶ Is male
- ► Holds children are the focus of the mission? No.

LCMS Preschool Director

- Less likely to be a member of an LCMS congregation
- Not a member of synod
- Did not attend a Concordia
- Did not subscribe to the Book of Concord
- ▶ Is female
- ► Holds children are the focus of the mission? Yes.




